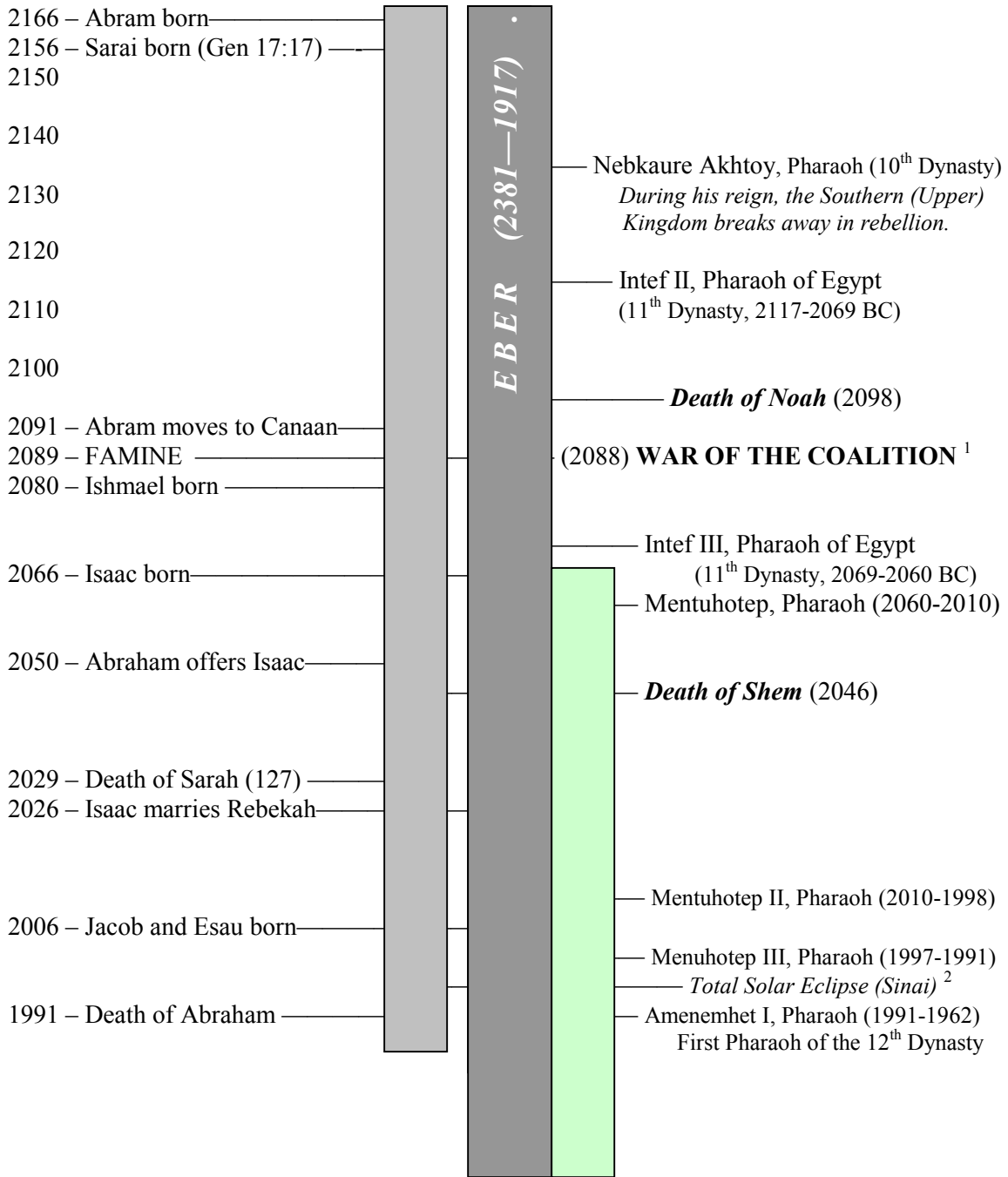


AN EXPANDED CHRONOLOGY OF ABRAHAM'S LIFE



¹ Perhaps as a result of the famine of 2089. Amraphael king of Shinar, and the kings of Ellasar, Elam and the Goiim go to war against the kings of Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, Zeboiim and Zoar. The northern (Old Babylonian) kings are victorious, and Lot is taken captive with hundreds of others. Abram and 318 of his own soldiers attack the group and route them all the way to Hobah north of Damascus and rescue Lot, all his household and goods. Abram is met by Melchizedech the priest-king of Salem (Jerusalem) and tithes to him. (Genesis 14:1-20)
